Ashikaga Meisen

A yarn-dyed fabric (fabric with pre-dyed yarn) that uses silk manufactured in Ashikaga. It is said that it has existed since around the mid-Edo Period (around 1700 - 1800). A logical production method that led to mass production of Meisen was established at Ashikaga. Bijin-ga work, that depicted beautiful women wearing Ashikaga Meisen, that were created by first-class master painters

of the time, were available nationwide as posters and picture postcards

7 Ashikaga Flower Park

1 Bannaji Temple An ancient temple that was established over 800 years ago in 1196 by Ashikaga Yoshikane during the Kamakura Period. (Yoshikane is an ancestor of Ashikaga Takauji, the first shogun of the Muromachi shogunate) Located at the center of Ashikaga City, and has a site area of approximately 40,000 square meters. It is surrounded by moats at all sides. The temple is home to the "Omido (main hall)" designated as a national treasure, a nationally designated important cultural property "Shoro," "Issaikyodo," and a large ginkgo tree which is a Tochigi Prefecture designated natural monument that is said to be approximately 600 years old. This large ginkgo tree changes into a magnificent yellow color during the autumn season.

Historic Site Ashikaga Gakko

Ashikaga Gakko is known as the oldest school in Japan and its remains were designated as a national historic site in 1921. There were many students that studied "Confucianism" and "Divination" during the Muromachi Period (1336 to 1573), and the school was Japan's top educational institution from the early years of the 15th century to the mid-15th century. In 1549, the school was spoken about overseas by Francis Xavier who had stated that it was the "largest and most famous University in Eastern Japan."

The world's largest ceramic museum with a collection of more than 2,000 Imari and Nabeshima ceramics. There

are 20 refined buildings including the main building, historical museum, and ceramics hall located on a nature rich place of scenic beauty that spans approximately 80,000 m². and is attracting attention from the world as a unique museum.

Two "Great Wisteria" said to be approximately 150 years old hang a cluster of purple flowers that span a total area

of approximately 2,000 m², and visitors that witness this splendid view erupt in joy from admiration. The Great

Wisteria and a 80 meter long white Wisteria tunnel are designated as natural monuments of Tochigi Prefecture,

and the "The Great Wisteria Festival" is held every year from mid-April to mid-May which is also the best time to

see the flowers. In addition, the illumination "The garden of illuminated flowers" which is held from late October to

February the following year was selected as one of Japan's three most spectacular illuminations which was

certified by YAKEI Convention & Visitors Bureau. It has also been awarded as the best domestic illumination on the illumination ranking, a ranking selected by certified night view experts, for 5 consecutive years. It was the only

> Nagusa Kyosekigun is an accumulation of large rocks

along the valley inhabited by fireflies located on the upper stream of Nagusa River. The Kyosekigun which are located around the Nagusa Benten are rocks which weathered and split from a large granite rock. Its

origin is highly relevant academically and is designated as a national natural monument.

9 COCO Farm & Winery

The Kabasaki Hachimangu Shrine is said to be the model of the shrine the main character of a popular anime show live in. It is inside the Kabasaki Temple ruins (national historic site) which was created by Ashikaga Yoshikane, the founder of the Bannaii Temple, to commend the souls of his companions to god. The current hall was renovated in 1989. The natural scenery around the location and the shrine is said to be perfectly depicted in the anime by fans.





Ashikaga Flower Park

If you are a fan of anime, doesn't the purple Great Wisteria in full bloom at Ashikaga Flower Park look familiar? This purple Great Wisteria was said to greatly resemble the scene where Wisteria is depicted in the popular anime which was a global hit. 5 Butsugaiken Tearoom and Garden This tearoom and garden belonged

to one of Ashikaga's wealthiest merchants and was constructed near the Watarase River in the early years of the Meiji Period (around 1870). It was relocated to its current location in 1901.
